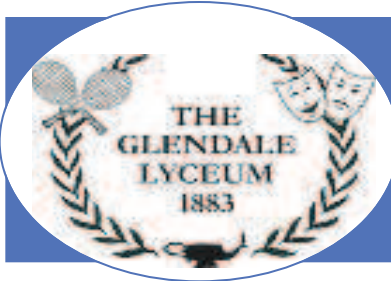

President's Letter

January 2014

I hope everyone enjoyed the holidays and is looking forward to 2014. The past year flew by but I think it is worthwhile to take a moment and look back at a couple of accomplishments at the Lyceum during 2013. The newly completed Pub certainly is at the top of the list. After years of planning and hard work, the space is completed and ready for use. Be sure to attend the Super Bowl XLVIII party in the Pub on February 2, 2014. The new audiovisual equipment donated by members is to be installed and fully operational. Plans have been finalized for the dedication party honoring those involved in the project on February 7th. Watch your email for details.

Another major accomplishment has been the establishment of the Legacy Fund for capital improvements. Under the leadership of our Treasurer, Gary Stuart, the campaign is off to a good start but we still are waiting to hear from a number of members. The success of the fund will be determined by the level of participation of the members. If you have already donated or pledged gifts—thank you. If you have not yet responded, please do so. With everyone's participation, it will be a great success and enhance the Lyceum for generations to come.

I think it is also worthwhile mentioning that in addition to pursuing the Legacy Fund, the board was exceedingly diligent in trying to be fiscally sound throughout 2013. For the second year in a row, we have avoided selling any of our stock. Given that we rely upon the substantial dividends that the stock generates, this bodes well and does not further compromise future budgets. The board has also approved increasing dues 2% effective January 1, 2014 to keep up with our expenses and remain financially stable.

Finally, we are about to kick off a new initiative at the Lyceum—a Strategic Planning Committee under the leadership and guidance of past president Bob VeVerka. This is an important endeavor and we look forward to its insights and results. A partial committee has been selected and if anyone has a desire to be considered for the committee, please contact Bob or myself for details. The first meeting will take place in February.

I hope to see you all at the Annual Meeting January 20th. Thanks for your support throughout the year.

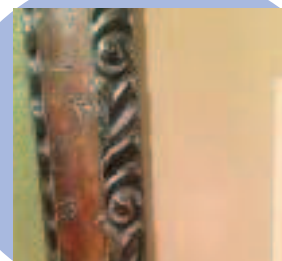
